Please look over our privacy policy below so that you can feel secure that none of your information will be used in any way other than to help you achieve your goal of completing the driver's education, defensive driving and risk reduction (DUI) courses.

Our company is committed to the protection of your privacy, and will treat all of the information you provide, including your registration information, with the highest respect. We work carefully to ensure that all measures have been taken to prevent the unauthorized or unlawful use of your personally identifiable information, and to prevent any accidental loss or destruction of, or damage to such information. Our company will not sell or disclose personally identifiable information about you to unaffiliated third parties except in accordance with this "Privacy Policy".

Information Collected, Use and Sharing:

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to and collect information that you voluntarily give us when you register for a class via email, website or other direct contact from you. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone. All data is processed and stored. The information that we collect from you are for record keeping only based on the DMV requirement. The information collected is your date of birth, social security number for online service, credit card information or banking information, your banking information and social security number is not shared with anyone. We will use your information to respond to you, regarding the reason you contacted us. We will not share your information with any third party outside of our organization, other than as necessary to fulfill your request for certain services, like to process payment transactions, to facilitate billing, and otherwise deliver the payment. We will not accept any payment or knowingly collect personally identifiable contact information from anyone under the age of 13.

An important part of our business at 1st Atlanta Area driving School is to protecting personally identifiable information about our students. We share and disclose such information only as described below.

We are obligated to share your information with the department of Motor vehicles. 1st Atlanta Area driving School is in communication with the Georgia Department of Driver Services regarding your attendance in one of our classes. This information is handled in an approved and regulated matter so no information is compromised.

Security

We take extra precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline. Whenever we collect sensitive information such as credit card data, that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a closed lock icon at the bottom of your web browser. While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, billing or customer service) are granted access to your information

Return Policy

In the event that you registered and paid for one of our classes and for some reason you are unable to attend, we may allow you to change your scheduled date and time to another available class under certain circumstances. These situations will be determined on an individual basis and we ask that you give at least a 24 hours notice to approve any changes. All payments are final all fees are non-refundable once you have registered and paid.
